



# Christmas Wreath

## Supplies for your wreath



You will need:

- various colours of construction paper (green and red mainly...)
- light card (for printing out the template)
- pencil
- permanent marker
- paper plate (more likely to be plastic these days...)
- red yarn (for holly sized pom poms - optional)
- glue stick or glue gun
- paper scissors
- holly leaf and berry template

## Directions...

1. Gather all of your materials together. Trace around the leaf templates on your pieces of coloured paper and cut out your leaves.
2. Cut the center out of your disposable dinner plate (an adult should probably do this bit...).
3. Cut out the holly leaf from the template and use it to draw leaves on your green card and then cut them out. I cut out 14 leaves and 7 groups of 3 berries. Apply glue to the back of one of your leaves using a glue stick or glue gun and place another holly leaf on top. Then glue on three holly berries in the middle of where your leaves overlap.
4. Glue your holly leaf sets onto the back of your dinner plate one at a time spacing them neatly all the way around. **Optional:** You can use small red pom poms instead of the card board berries to add texture to your wreath if you want to.

Then all you need to do is glue some string at the back so that you can hang your wreath - I decided to use tinsel - but you can use whatever you have handy.
