



See Through Pictures

Supplies for your pictures



You will need:

- gel medium (found in arts and crafts store)
- magazine picture or a picture you have drawn or printed onto shiny shelf paper
- paint brush or foam applicator
- drop sheet to protect the work space
- artists smocks for the kids

Directions...

1. Collect all your materials together and place a drop sheet or protective cover on your work space.
2. Lay your paper picture side up on your flat work surface and apply a coat of the gel to your picture. Leave to dry.
3. Repeat the previous step until you have 12 coats of the gel on your picture and leave to dry.
4. Soak your picture in water until you can peel the paper off the back of your picture.

Tips:

The gel medium mentioned below can be found in your local craft store.

We have found that drawn pictures make the best and most original pictures. Some magazine pictures cannot be used because the picture on the back gets "in the way".

When using magazine pictures, pick the pictures that have as little on the back as possible.
