



Table Top Christmas Tree

Supplies for your Christmas Tree...



You will need:

- polystyrene cone
- 2 strings of tinsel - one green and one silver
- sticky tape
- spray on adhesive
- push pins
- scraps of card or old Christmas cards
- Christmas tree decoration template

Directions...

1. Gather together all of your materials and prepare the work area.
2. Using the sticky tape, firmly attach one end of the green tinsel to the top of the cone. Wind the tinsel around the cone all the way to the base. Trim the excess and secure on the base with sticky tape.
3. Trim a small piece of the silver tinsel. Spray your tree with the spray adhesive and sprinkle the cut tinsel over the tree.

Tip: *If it doesn't all stick, you can roll the tree in the tinsel.*

4. When your spray adhesive is no longer tacky, you can start adding decorations to your tree.

For mine I cut out 2 small stars and covered them with red and silver glitter. I pasted them together with a toothpick in between so that it could be stuck into the top of the tree.

The kids can make other decorations by cutting out Christmas shapes from old Christmas cards or by printing out my template and colouring in the shapes that they like. With an adult's help they can stick their decorations onto the tree using small push pins.
